2020-2021 Online Registration and Fee Payment for ALL STUDENTS

REGISTRATION IS VERY IMPORTANT. IT IS NECESSARY FOR YOUR CHILD TO BEGIN SCHOOL WITH THE PROPER MATERIALS AND INFORMATION. Normally, on-site registration occurs in late July or early August. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, we are awaiting guidelines from the MCPSS Superintendent who is being advised by the State Superintendent and the CDC. The information on this page will help you prepare for on-site registration during which time students receive their schedules, purchase PE uniforms, and pay for yearbooks and the Shakespeare Festival. Parents will be notified by phone, email, and the school's website once we schedule dates for these purchases/payments.

TEXTBOOKS will be issued the first week of school. **All textbook and library fines must be paid before** textbooks can be issued for this year. Payments may be made in the office.

SHAKESPEARE FESTIVAL TICKETS FOR EIGHTH GRADE STUDENTS WILL BE

(TENTATIVELY) SOLD AT THE SCHOOL IN AUGUST. Each year, 8th graders travel by charter bus to Montgomery to see a production of Shakespeare. Tickets must be purchased immediately to ensure seating for our class of approximately 200 students. The cost of the ticket is \$20.00. Payments may be made by cash, check or money order. Charter bus tickets will be sold in the spring of 2021 and will cost approximately \$30.00. Please DO NOT pay for the bus in August.

If paying by check or money order, you may fill out the form and staple your check to the form and drop both in the box provided in the cafeteria/lobby. If paying in cash, you must wait for a receipt. NOTE: If a student has any major discipline problems or is failing a class during the school year, the administration will determine whether or not the student is allowed to go on the trip. THERE IS NO REFUND FOR THE TICKET.

The 2020-2021 YEARBOOK WILL BE ON SALE IN AUGUST. The down payment is \$15.00. Full payment is \$30.00. Each year, students who missed out reserving a copy of the yearbook are often disappointed in the spring when none are available. Complete the form and staple your check or money order to the form and drop both in the box provided at the yearbook table. If paying in cash, you must wait for a receipt.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORMS ARE REQUIRED AT PHILLIPS. The warm weather uniform is a 50/50 poly-cotton blend T-shirt and shorts. The cost is **\$10.00 for each piece**. Returning Phillips' students are not required to purchase new uniforms. Winter-wear will be available later in the school year for \$15 for each piece.
