### McConnell-Talbert Stadium Press Box Dedication



HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The school district will honor Michael "Mike" D. Davis by naming the McConnell-Talbert Stadium press box after him. A dedication ceremony and presentation to his family for the "Mike Davis Press Box" will take place Aug. 23, at 7:10 p.m., before a Northside High School football game.

Davis devoted 25 years to the student athletes of Houston County as a radio broadcaster from 1994 through 2018. He began his broadcast career in 1994 when he accompanied Jeff Chandler to help one night at a game. That one night turned into a passion for promoting students; he was a consummate champion of Houston County athletics.

Davis was a native of Warner Robins and a 1971 Northside High graduate. He and his wife, Diane, were married for 33 years before he passed away on Jan. 26, 2019. He is remembered for his love of family, friends and community. Even those who never met him in person will remember the sound of his voice as he called plays Friday nights on the airwaves.

Davis also founded SportsMic with Conrad Nix, Greg Elrod and others. SportsMic covers the district's athletic programs, with live broadcasts on game day for high school football and other sports in Houston County.

Northside High will play Centennial High this Friday evening. The McConnell-Talbert Stadium is located at 401 South Davis Drive in Warner Robins.
