

**510.2 L GRADE 4-12 ATHLETICS, FINE ARTS, AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION  
- EXTRA CURRICULAR PROGRAMS -**

**I. PURPOSE**

The New York Mills School District offers 9-12 MSHSL Fine Arts and Athletic opportunities in several categories. Also, there are various junior high and elementary after school and community education school year and summer recreation opportunities. In every school sponsored activity, there are people named by the school to be directly responsible for the scheduling and supervision of these activities.

**II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY**

Varsity coaches are expected to guide the entire program for their designated assignments. He/she shall meet with coaches on lower levels of the program to communicate his/her philosophy in the development of the activity to its full potential. The Varsity coach is also responsible to monitor and assist the Activities Director in the enforcement of all School and MSHSL policies in their respective activities.

**III. COMMUNITY MEMBERS WISHING TO FORM EXTENDED-YEAR NEW YORK MILLS TEAMS**

Extended programs are not school sponsored. The use of the school logo is not permitted by non-school sponsored teams/organizations. Any community or parent group seeking use of school facilities for extended year team or individual use must submit a Facility Request Form for consideration. The School District Rental Policy shall be applicable for rental fees.

If any group seeks the "Non-Profit" wavier rate, an IRS 501(C) 3 Tax Exempt Certificate must be attached. A certificate of liability insurance will also be required. If the extended-year program meets the above requirements, and is open to all resident school district students, and if the participants are divided so that teams are of equal ability, \$1.00 will be assessed for the use of the facility.

**IV. NON SCHOOL EXTENDED-YEAR PROGRAMS**

- A. Must be clearly designated as "Non-School" activities.
- B. May not involve student in fund-raising activities during school hours.
- C. Are not eligible for school district transportation or other school financial contributions.
- D. Any Booster Club sponsored events should charge sufficient entry and gate fees to help offset any rental/charges for use of the facilities, supervisors, cleanup, etc.
