Here's a skill that will come in handy when your child works with partners or groups: collaboration. He'll need to exchange opinions and solve problems throughout his school career and in future jobs. Share these tips.

Think before answering.

In a good discussion, each person builds on others' responses. Practice by asking a "Would you rather" question, such as "Would you rather fly like a bird or transport anywhere instantly?" Maybe you'll say "teleporting" is better because you'd get home from work quickly. Your youngster might reply, "I agree that teleporting would be faster, but I'd like to fly and look at the world below."

Negotiate thoughtfully.

Appoint your child "consensus builder" for one week. His job is to think of compromises. Say one family member wants tacos for dinner and another wants pasta. Perhaps he'll suggest a "tacospaghetti bar" where you have tortillas and noodles, with toppings for both.♥
