Dear BEHS Parents/Guardians,

Bamberg School District One will be going to four days of face-to-face instruction and one day of virtual instruction starting during the last week of October.

Face-to-face students will attend Monday through Thursday in person. On Fridays, all students (virtual and face-to-face) will participate virtually. Students, who are currently virtual, will continue their normal virtual schedule Monday through Friday. This schedule will begin on Monday, October 26, 2020. The first Friday that will be virtual for all students will be Friday, October 30, 2020.

This decision was made utilizing input from the parent survey that was posted online as well as teacher input. Results from the survey showed 72.1% of parents preferred some form of release day and 69.5% preferred it to be a Friday. With those considerations taken, it was decided that the release day would come on Fridays.

This virtual day will enable the custodial staff at Bamberg-Ehrhardt High School an opportunity to deep clean the buildings on campus. This day will also be used to provide an opportunity for teacher planning and provide teachers with opportunities for professional development. During this day, all students will be expected to participate virtually.

Meal deliveries will go out to bus students on Fridays between the hours of 11:30 am and 1:30 pm. Meals can be picked up at RCES at 11 AM on Friday mornings.
