Mask Update:

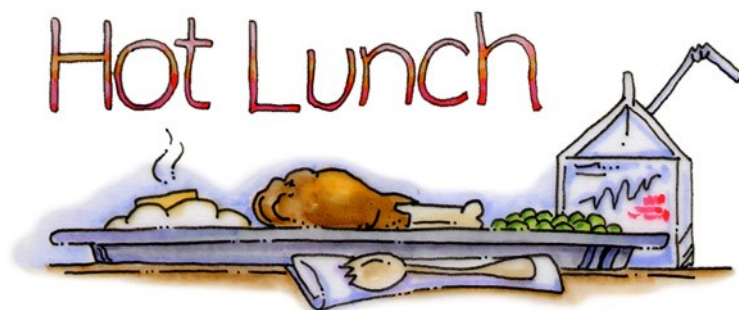
