Websites:

Author's last name. First name. "Title of site in quotations." Date of Publication posting or revision. Name of sponsor or institution/organization affiliated with the site. Format. Date you accessed the site.

Example:

Lloyd, Gordon. "The Purdue OWL Family of Sites." 10/23/08. Purdue University Writing Center. Web. 9/09/12.

Web site Primary Source:

Author of original piece. "Title of original piece." Translator of piece (if relevant). Year Original piece was written. Sponsoring organization. Format. Date accessed.

Example:

Washington, George."Letter from George Washington to Josiah Thompson." July 2, 1766. American Memory.Web 9/24/12.

Web Site : encyclopedia, book, magazine or newspaper on a web site

Author's last name, First. "Title of article." <u>Title of encyclopedia, book, newspaper</u> <u>underlined</u>. Date of publication, posting or revision. Name of sponsor.Format. Date accessed..

Example:

McDonald, Forrest. "Constitutional Convention." <u>Grolier Multimedia Encyclopedia.</u> 2009. GrolierOnline.. Web. Sept.20, 2012.

Book

Author's last name, First. <u>Title of Book.</u> Place of Publication : Publisher, date of publication or copyright date. Format.

Example:

Straight, Susan. <u>A Million Nightingales.</u> N.Y.: MacMillian, 2008. Print.

Book with two or more authors

- First author's last name, first author's first name, and next author's first and last name. <u>Title of book underlined.</u> Place of Publication : Publisher, copyright date. Format.
- Example: Christianson, Mary and Geroge Jenkins. <u>The American Revolution</u>. N:Y: Little & Brown, 2011. Print.

Encyclopedia

- Author last name, first (if given)."Title of article." <u>Title of Encyclopedia underlined.</u> Volume number and edition (if given). City of Publication: Publisher, year. Format.
- Weiss, Arthur. "New Zealand." <u>World Book.</u> Vol 4, 22ed. Chicago: World Book, 2010. Print.

Magazine Article

Author's last name, First name. "Title of article." <u>Title of Magazine underlined</u> volume Number (if any). Date of publication : page numbers. Format.

Example:

Park, Alice. "Waste Not." Time. Vol 180, no 11, Sept.10,2012, pg82. Print.

Newspaper Article

Author's last name. First. "Title of article." <u>Title of newspaper underlined.</u> Date of Publication, section, page numbers. Format.

Example:

Megan, Kathleen."3M Gift Primes Fundraising Campaign," <u>Hartford Courant.</u> 9/24/12, sec A,pg 1. Print. 9/12
