Federal and state laws require that school districts identify children of preschool age who may have disabilities that hinder the child's ability to learn.

INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

A preschool child, including homeless and migrant, between 3-5 and not eligible for kindergarten in September.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS DO YOU HAVE CONCERNS ABOUT THE EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF YOUR CHILD IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS?:

Communication

Understand and participates in conversations, uses complex sentences and vocabulary to express ideas and needs, shows an understanding of stories

Motor/Physical

Uses coordinated large muscle movements, uses coordinated small muscle movements, cares for self independently

Cognitive

Sorts objects, recognizes and makes patterns, compares and orders objects and events

Emotional

Uses appropriate words or action to express emotions or feelings

Visual or Hearing

Difficulty focusing, has speech difficulties, speaks loudly

Social

Manages transitions, follows routines and rules, interacts cooperatively with others
