Right now, your child will only have a minimal nightly homework to help get them adjusted. Remember everyone should be also reading a book of their choice nightly. Each week you should practice spelling words and review the sight words/high-frequency words listed on the newsletter. Homework should not take more that 30 minutes per night.
