HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – Perry High School participated in the Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) Georgia Fall Virtual Leadership Rally in October. Students won two first place awards and were presented blue ribbons, as well as prize money for their FCCLA chapter.

Janna Young, a junior, won first place in the peanut recipe competition. Young had to create two different recipes for original side dishes. She created two boiled peanut hummus recipes: a traditional recipe with fresh garlic and lemon flavor and a Thai-inspired recipe with green onions, Sriracha sauce and cilantro. After preparing the dishes, a focus group of three individuals tasted the food and gave verbal and written evaluations of both. The focus group selected the Thai version as the winner, but enjoyed both recipes.
