Summer Meals Offered for Children

HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Houston County School Nutrition Program will continue operations this summer, offering meals free of charge to children ages 18 and under, through July 29, 2020. Children do not need to be enrolled in the Houston County School District to receive meals.

Meals are offered at four schools: Northside High, Huntington Middle, Matt Arthur Elementary, and Tucker Elementary. Two breakfasts and two lunches will be provided on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 11 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the car rider or bus lane. In addition, seven mobile routes will continue traveling scheduled routes through Houston County neighborhoods to serve children who are unable to access one of the school sites.

Meredith Potter, Director of School Nutrition, states, “We are fortunate to be able to serve our community during this difficult time. Our plan at this point is to continue serving meals through the summer, so that families benefit from this opportunity to receive meals for children.”
