

Good evening parents of the Randolph County School System,

This is Stephen Gainey. I am calling to provide a follow-up to the announcement made by Governor Roy Cooper on 2/2/21. The announcement referenced the opening of schools in our state. However, after reviewing the information, the announcement on 2/2/21 does not appear to affect our school system's current plan. As a result, all PreK students and students in grades K-5 will continue to attend school for four days per week on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday for face-to-face instruction. Wednesday will remain as a "remote instruction day" for these students.

For grades 6-12, the A day/B day format will remain in place. As a result, Group A students will continue to attend school for face-to-face instruction on Monday and Tuesday. Group B students will continue to attend school for face-to-face instruction on Thursday and Friday. All students will be engaged in remote instruction on Wednesday. Furthermore, students will be engaged in remote instruction on days during the week when not on campus.

Please know that the leadership of the school system will continue to review the information related to the Governor's announcement on 2/2/21, as well as any future announcements, and adjust our school system's plan as needed. Nonetheless, at this time, no changes to the school system's plan will be made.

In addition to the previously-noted information, please note that the school system will continue to make great efforts to maintain safe conditions for our students, staff members, and visitors to school campuses.
