**Transition Night:** Transition Night will be on Tuesday, May 5 via Zoom. Sixth grade will be at 6:00 and 8th grade will be at 7:00. Students should have received documents in the mail, but if not, please contact Mrs. Steele.

**PreK and Kinder Registration:** PK and Kindergarten registration will be done virtually via this link: <https://forms.gle/gSyun1aFXHoQGS9N7>. The link will be posted on our website, the school's Facebook page, and sent out via our One Call system. This link will allow us to add your child to a planning roster. They will register in August during New Student Registration. Those dates have not been decided yet.

**Dual Credit Registration:** Fall 2020 dual credit registration will be done virtually via this link: <https://forms.gle/UuivEhFDhdWtQUbx5>. The link will be posted on our website, the school's Facebook page, and sent out via our One Call system to appropriate students. This link will allow Mrs. Ribble to register your child for their Fall 2020 classes, know who needs to take the TSI, and contact those students who have questions.

**Graduation:** Graduation has not been decided at this point. Our seniors received a letter and a Google Form with graduation options. The district is waiting for clarification from our state and county leaders on what will be permissible before a decision is made.

May First Baptist Church was scheduled to host the Baccalaureate this year. The church will give each senior a personalized bible in keeping with established tradition. Details about the Baccalaureate ceremony will be announced with the commencement plans.

**Free Meals:** Free meals offered through the school will end on May 22, 2020.

**Athletic Uniform Return:** During Personal Student Belonging Pick-up on May 6, our coaching staff will be collecting all athletic uniforms. This includes old track uniforms used during cross country, hoodies, sweats, as well as new track uniforms, baseball, basketball practice and game uniforms, and softball uniforms. Your child's name will be marked off the list when those items are returned.

## **2020 Material Return Plan:**

### **Phase 1: Student Personal Belonging Pick-up**

**Teachers and Coaches:** Put all individual student belongings in a bag that will be handed to parents as they drive through the pick-up line. Teachers will be at school to help facilitate pick-up.

**Parents:** Will come to the school at their designated time to pick up their child's personal belongings. JH and HS students can also get their athletic belongings that were left in the locker rooms. Students will return all athletic uniforms.

**Window:** Wednesday, May 6. We will use the same time slots as we did for material pick-up below:

- 10:30-11:30: 9th & 10th, Elem: 4th & 3rd

## Phase 2: School Material and Technology Return
