PHS REOPENING PLAN

Entering and Exiting School Buildings

- Parents and visitors will not be allowed past the front office for any reason.
- School Meet and Greets and new student orientations will be virtual.
- School volunteers will not be allowed.
- Parents will not be allowed to walk students to the classroom.
- Safety precautions will include social distancing markings and one-way building entrances and exits.
- A staff member at the car and bus ramp will remind students to social distance.
- Parent conferences will be conducted either virtually or in the office with proper social distancing.
- School Council meetings will be conducted virtually.
- High-touch surfaces will be regularly cleaned and disinfected.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES

- Students will be allowed in the building at 7:15a.m.
 - Must report to 1st period upon arrival of school
 - Breakfast will be available in two locations
 - Cafeteria for bus riders
 - Commons Area for car riders
- 1st Period Class Begins at 8:00a.m
- Students will be allowed between 7:15a.m and 7:55a.m to use their devices while in the classroom.
 - Students will not be able to talk on their phones, take pictures, record videos, or disturb their fellow classmates or teacher with their devices.
 - Students must adhere to teacher classroom rules

Breakfast

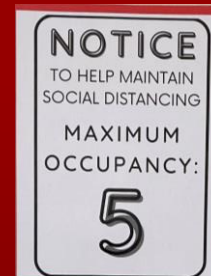
- Breakfast will be grab and go

TRANSITIONS BETWEEN CLASSES

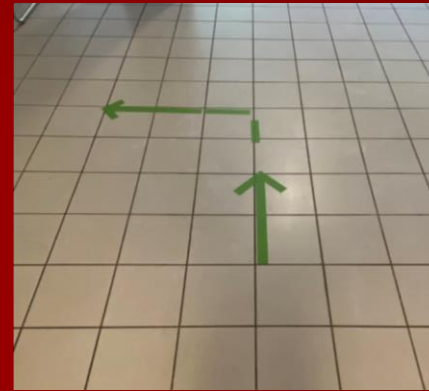
- Due to social distancing, each hall is one way

DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

- Staggered Release Times for Social Distancing
 - Bus riders and students will be dismissed at 2:00pm
 - Drivers and walkers will be released at 2:05p.m.
 - Car Riders will be released at 2:10p.m.
- Students participating in extracurricular activities after school must report to their designated locations immediately upon release of 6th period.

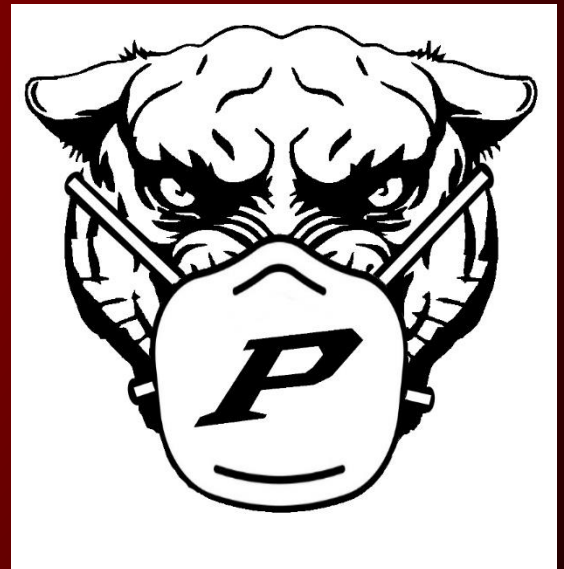
