Business Administrator's Report:

- Summer Work
 - Mark Towle has been working with Dennis Rainville this summer, painting, repairing and deep cleaning
 - Mike Josselyn has aerated, fertilized and added sand to the ballfield area. Will return in August for fall treatment including the lawn area
 - Window replacement began today with Dan Hebert Inc.
 - Floor replacement will begin as soon as the product arrives
 - Installing the quarry tile in the kitchen
 - Routine work is in process of being scheduled

- Funding
 - CARES Act ESSER Grant – estimated to receive \$ 80,604
 - Title I \$ 92,276 preliminary allocation
- Transportation
 - Parent request – Last spring a parent requested their child ride the Stewartstown bus in the afternoons to Stewartstown
 - Bus recall on Bus

New Business:

- School re-entry
 - Dr Taylor is meeting with the Administrator Team on Wednesday.
 - The Governor has promised guidelines by mid-July
 - The Taskforce has presented 10 recommendations to the Governor
 - Dr Taylor has been in contact with the NHSAA to discuss reentry guidelines
 - Reviewed models proposed by other districts.
 - We will be looking at the following three models
 - Full opening on school with modifications
 - Hybrid model some in person and home remote instruction
 - Full remote learning
 - Different school environment:
 - New Health and Safety measures
 - Communicate and work with Canaan as we share students
- Staffing update
 - Discussed hiring a p/t para educator to share with Pittsburg to assist with staffing
 - Discuss at the August SAU meeting substitute pay
