YES	YES COVID-19 POSITIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● After 10 full days since symptoms first appeared; AND ● At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication; AND ● Symptoms have improved.
YES	YES COVID-19 NEGATIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● At least 24 hours with no fever without fever- reducing medication; AND ● Symptoms have improved
NO	YES COVID-19 POSITIVE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● After 10 full days have passed since test
CONFIRMED POSITIVE HOUSEHOLD MEMBER THAT CANNOT COMPLETELY SEPARATE FROM STUDENT		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● After 20 full days following a positive test or symptom onset of the household member. No test required. OR ● After 17 full days following exposure with a negative test no more than 48 hours prior to end of quarantine. <p style="text-align: center;"><i>*If the student develops symptoms, notify the nurse and refer to guidance above.</i></p>
CLOSE CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WITH COVID-19**		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● After 10 full days following exposure unless he/she develops symptoms, in which case see above. No test required. OR ● After 7 full days following exposure with a negative test no more than 48 hours prior to end of quarantine.
SECONDARY CONTACT (Contact with someone who had contact with someone else with COVID-19)		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Self-monitor for symptoms ● No need to quarantine
AWAITING TEST RESULTS		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Isolate at home until results are received.

** The CDC and PA DOH introduced a shortened quarantine option for close contacts of 10 days. Please monitor for symptoms for a full 14 days regardless of negative test or return to school. Known exposure to variant strain requires 14 day quarantine. Proof of negative test must be given to school prior to return.*
