Approval of Minutes

M. Lambeth made a motion seconded by G. Lawson that minutes of the meeting held on April 20, 2009, be approved as presented. The motion carried: 6-0.

Public Comments

Daryl Barnes representing the Principals' Association, Sharon Andrews representing the Assistant Principals' Association and Madeline Reed, President of the Randolph County Association of Educators all expressed concerns brought from these organizations of a proposal that was put forth suggesting that Randolph County administrators take a three percent pay cut in their supplements and that teachers also take a one percent cut in their supplements.

Adoption of Agenda

G. Cook made a motion seconded by G. Lawson that the Board adopts the agenda as presented. The motion carried: 6-0.

Consent Items

Superintendent Andrews presented consent items for approval with the exception of the revision as presented to Agenda Item one, Student Assignments and Releases, by removing the five names listed under Ramseur Elementary. These names will be presented for approval at the June 15, 2009 Board meeting.

P. Guthrie made a motion seconded by G. Cook that the Board approves consent items as presented with the exception of revisions to Consent Agenda Item 1- Student Assignments and Releases as mention above. The motion carried: 6-0.

1. Assignments and Releases – Fourteen (14) student releases and assignments for 2008-2009 were presented for approval. One (1) request was denied. Four (4) students released to Asheboro City and surrounding counties. Two hundred and sixty-eight (268) student releases and assignments for 2009-2010 were presented for approved except for the revision of five students from Ramseur Elementary as mentioned above. Thirty-seven (37) requests were denied in accordance with Board directives and twelve (12) students have been released to Asheboro City and surrounding counties.

Budget Information Update

Todd Lowe, Finance Officer, stated that in April Randolph County Schools received information that there would be a state spending freeze along with a second reversion of \$530,818.00 (non-instructional support). Mr. Lowe also stated that there would be a .5 % salary reduction for May and June for employees with the ten hour flexible leave in return.

Summer Hours Signage/Options

Superintendent Andrews presented information concerning the summer work hours including hours of operation, options for working the ten hour days, and recommendations for notifying parents and the community. System wide office hours will be Monday – Thursday 7:30 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. Summer schedule begins the week of July 6, 2009 and ends Friday, August 14, 2009.

Energy Conservation

W.G. Potts of Educon Educational Consulting, Inc. presented information concerning energy conservation. The information presented proved how conservation continues to be important due to the rate increases continuing. Strategies presented were: continue monitoring, reduce HVAC run times when practical, encourage care in use of overrides, continue the efforts to raise awareness and increase cooperation of all staff and students in following energy guidelines. Mr. Potts presented utility savings with the program of 9%, consumption of water use down 14%, heating oil use down 16.5%, natural gas use down 6.1%, and electricity use down 9%.

Facility Planning and Construction Update

Marty Trotter, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, presented information concerning use of facilities with the hourly fee schedule along with the board policy concerning use of facilities. Mr. Trotter stated we are currently not charging parks and recreation leagues and athletic associations. The board was asked if they would support charges to these groups. Mr. Trotter stated that a weekly rate could be developed instead of a per hour rate. Mr. Trotter reported that the High School gym HVAC project is expected to be completed by May 22, 2009. Weekly meetings are continuing to take place with the general contractor for Wheatmore High School. The next meeting will be Tuesday, May 26th. Major trades are well underway. There is water now on site. Concerns were expressed with a lot of trespassing on the school construction site. Mr. Trotter discussed getting pricing to put up fencing around the property.

Wheatmore High School Update

Daryl Barnes, Principal of Wheatmore High School, reported that the website was up and running. There are two certified positions and two classified positions to be filled. There is still a need for a softball and girls basketball coach. Cheerleading tryouts will take place on June 15, 2009. Mr. Barnes also stated that the master schedule is also complete.

Closed Session

J. Johnson made a motion seconded by G. Cook that the Board go into closed session to discuss the terms of an employment contract as provided in North Carolina General Statute 143.318.11(a)(5) and to consider a personnel matter that involves an employee as provided in North Carolina General Statute 143.318.11(a)(6). The motion carried: 6-0.

Appointment

G. Lawson made a motion seconded by J. Johnson to accept the recommendation of Superintendent Andrews to approve Ms. Jennifer Williams as Principal of Liberty Elementary School effective July 1, 2009. Motion carried: 6-0.
