

Bulletin column January 12, 2020 "From the Pastor"

Dear parishioners,

This weekend's celebration, the Baptism of the Lord, concludes the Christmas season in the Church's post-conciliar rites. For hundreds of years prior to the Vatican Council, the Christmas season continued all the way until 2 February, Candlemas, or the Feast of the Presentation. As I have mentioned in past years, Pope Benedict during his pontificate encouraged Catholics to maintain this ancient sense and keep their Christmas decorations up until the Presentation. I would encourage parishioners to do that. St. Michael's as a parish will turn off our Christmas lights after today until Candlemas, but will keep our other decorations up until that day.

Advent and Christmas have given us ample opportunity in our liturgy and readings to contemplate what a great gift God the Father has given us in Christ Jesus and the salvation He brings to us. We have explored this gift in the writings of the prophets, the reflections of epistles, and the various infancy narratives which tell us of the Child Jesus. The Baptism of the Lord invites us to turn toward the ministry of Jesus that will bring about that salvation. Our first reading from Isaiah predicts Jesus' preaching of the Good News and healing ministry in anticipation of the sacramental ministry He will do after His death and resurrection in freeing people everywhere who receive Him from sin and death. The second reading from Acts notes how Jesus' earthly ministry began with His baptism. St. Peter mentions that Jesus was "anointed with the Holy Spirit and power."

Jesus is, of course, God the Son. Why was He baptized? Even St. John the Baptist questioned the act, complaining that he needed to be baptized by Jesus, not the other way around. The anointing St. Peter talked about came in Jesus' baptism when the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in the form of a dove. Why was that anointing necessary?

St. Augustine encapsulates the mystery of the incarnation by telling us that "God became man so that man might become God." Jesus needed for His humanity to be sanctified in the act of His baptism so that He might pass that sanctified humanity on to us when we are baptized, for us to be given a humanity that can receive and carry divinity. Moreover, Jesus submits to His baptism in a way that is very much connected to how He will submit to His cross later. Just as Jesus did not need the conversion and sanctification of baptism, He would not deserve the punishment of the cross which was the merited death of sinners, not the sinless Son of God. He submits to both baptism and the cross because we need for Him to do so. It is in that submission, both to baptism and the cross, that the Father is pleased with Jesus' sacred humanity as His Messiah-Son and will be pleased with us when Jesus' Spirit dwells within us.

The Scriptures and the Church teach us that baptism is in fact a sharing in Jesus' suffering and death. Just as Jesus lay for three days in the tomb, we descend beneath the waters three times so that we might die with Jesus to sin, and thus be raised up to His new life. We are then called upon to allow the Spirit of Christ to make us more and more like Him throughout our lives; that is, to be one who loves God and loves our neighbor more and more through the sanctity of the Holy Spirit dwelling and acting within us. The Eucharist, the re-application of Jesus' saving cross in our

lives, is what strengthens and renews us in that Spirit.

We thank God at the close of this Christmas season for the precious gift of Jesus as we receive Him in His incarnation, His birth, His baptism, His death and resurrection, His Spirit, and His sacraments. We pray for an openness to the continuing work of Jesus' Spirit within us that we may grow in His holiness. Thus may the Father look upon each of us as His sons and daughters in whom He is well pleased; thus may the ministry of Jesus continue through us as He shares His love with our families, friends, and enemies who surround us through our cooperation with the Spirit's grace in the performance of loving good works; and thus may God be glorified and many more souls saved.

This past week, Fr. Mike's 60th birthday snuck up on me and a great many others. What a great milestone! I am hoping that we may celebrate it belatedly with ceremony when Father returns from his language studies. He has contributed so much of himself to the parish over the past two and a half years and deserves our appreciation. He deserves for us to celebrate him.

We certainly pray for Fr. Mike's safety, health, enjoyment, and success in his time in Guatemala. Father is very motivated to become more able to minister to the Spanish-speaking majority of the parish so that he may continue to minister here, and I very much appreciate that. As I have mentioned before, Fr. Mike's absence and Fr. Joseph Broudou's greater Spanish abilities will allow me to be more flexible with the Mass scheduling, to get to know many parishioners much better, and to share more in the diverse life and worship in the parish.

Some have commented that I do indeed need to work at being more present, visible, and engaged in the parish all around. I do believe that any perceptions of my "not being visible" in the parish have been greatly exacerbated over the past month by my ridiculous string of three illnesses. Also, whereas large numbers of parishioners may not see me at any given time, a lot of my work time is spent meeting with individuals and small groups – for example, in marriage preps, pastoral counseling, and in teaching our English RCIA class.

That said, the fact of the matter is that I am naturally an extreme introvert – my natural and most comfortable state is to work and grow and live in frequent solitude. However, as Christ was available to the people, I as priest and pastor have to be available to the people of St. Michael's. Moreover, I have found over the years that I tend to prosper (and even enjoy myself!) the most as a priest when I come out of that comfort zone to work among and in collaboration with God's people. Most of all, I hear what people are saying about the parish's need for my greater engagement and visibility. There is obviously an extreme need now for me to allow God to draw me anew out of that comfort zone here at St.

Michael's. I see this need in our parish, and plan with God's grace and help to seek to engage more with the flock and to be more available and visible. I ask everyone's prayers in responding to that call and that grace. I believe that God has a great 2020 planned for St. Michael's and look forward to working with all of the members of our parish to receive that gift and bring it to birth. May God bless us all at St. Michael's in this year to come!






