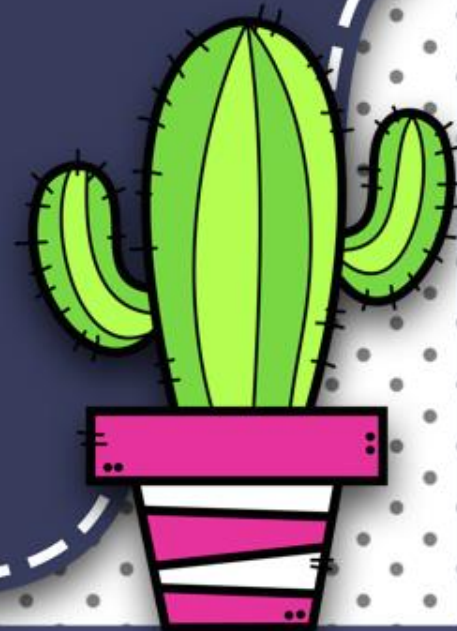
## Additional Requests:

And of course, if I have any concerns about grades, I will discuss it with you!





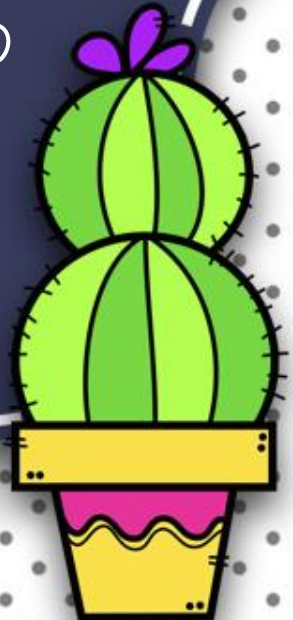
# HOMework

Homework is given on occasion as needed. Typically only when students need extra practice or if work was not completed in class. There will be a couple of home projects, but I will send those home far in advance, so you have time to work on them. You will need to check binders nightly for any homework due.



# SPECIALS

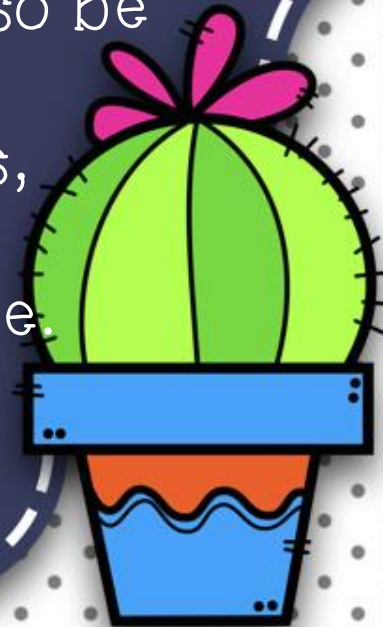
Students will go to Music Class and Library weekly. Mrs. Dutton, our Media Specialist, and Miss Stewart, our Music Teacher will be coming to our classroom during class times.





# PROCEDURES

Daily Binders will come home and return to school each day. Students are expected to check their binder for money, notes from parents, homework, etc. There will also be other tools in our binders such as newsletters, spelling lists, reading logs, etc. This is one way we can work towards being responsible in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.



# BEHAVIOR

Our behavior plan is simple. Students are expected to be KIND, RESPECTFUL, and SAFE. If a student is exhibiting a negative behavior, I pull them aside to discuss how we can correct it. If the problem persists, I will notify parents through Glass Dojo to help us correct the behavior. I do not use a clip chart, but we do play a “game” where students earn game pieces as a class for positive behavior. You will also see positive behavioral feedback in Glass Dojo, so be sure to check the app daily.
