# SANTA'S HELPERS 2020



Family Focus and Teen Focus have been helping families with Christmas expenses for several years. We want to continue helping families in our community. The process has some changes this year. Please read below for guidelines for this holiday season:

- To be eligible for our program:
  - 1. The family must qualify for <u>free</u> lunches <u>by HIF Lunch Forms</u>.
  - 2. The family cannot be receiving assistance from any other Christmas program.
  - 3. The children must be enrolled in **Ballard County Schools**.
  - 4. For children who are too young for school, parents must bring proof of Medicaid or SNAP benefits from Ballard County DCBS.
