Literacy Coaches

Preliminary Budget and Public Hearing for Budget

Finance Officer Todd Lowe presented the Archdale-Trinity Budget for 2008-2009 with a proposed increase to 9 cents. He also reviewed the Proposed Current Expense and Capital Outlay Budget Requests for the 2008-2009 school year. Chair LaVerne Williams opened the floor for public comments on the proposed budget, including the Archdale-Trinity Budget, for 2008-2009. There were no public comments. G. Cook made a motion seconded by J. Johnson that the budget requests be approved as presented. The motion carried: 7-0.

Marty Trotter reported for Principal Rick Dawes that the school's website had been constructed, the band boosters had met, the Chorus teacher had been selected, the Band Director position would be selected soon, the physical education and athletic equipment would be ordered this week, and he was waiting on quotes for the office furniture.

Construction Update

Marty Trotter, Director of Facilities and Construction, reported that sod for the Providence Grove football field would cost \$48,000 and the field could not be used during the first season. He also reported that Wheatmore would be completed by August 24, 2009, and that he was researching the feasibility of opening the school in the middle of the year.

Mr. Trotter reported briefly on a bus fire that occurred on Friday, April 11. Cause of the fire is undetermined, however, the bus is a total loss. Thanks to the quick response of the driver and her students, everyone got off the bus safely.
