Re-entry Plan

Updated July 21, 2020

Updates are fluid, based on current guidelines, and could possibly change.

General

- Staff will wear face coverings when they cannot provide instruction in a socially distanced manner
- Social distancing bubbles as well as arrows to direct control of traffic throughout the building and classrooms and ensure students remain at a safe distance
- Social distancing bubbles to remind all students and staff to remain the required distance apart in restrooms, locker rooms, gyms, hallways, etc.
- Limited visitors in the building
- Education on proper hygiene to limit transmission
- Posters/signs as reminders for proper protocols
- One way stairwells
- Teachers screened daily upon arrival
- Students screened daily upon arrival

Arrival

- Students will get off the bus, proceed up the middle or high school stairs, and go directly to their lockers then to their first period class. Teachers will be in doorways to monitor and limit congregating.
- Any student who arrives prior to first period will stop at the gymnasium and sit in socially distanced, marked seats until 7:30 at which time they will be released in a scattered manner to eliminate congregation. Teachers will be in the classroom doorways to monitor.
- Students will remain in first period until time for breakfast.

Drop off/Pick up

- Drop off time for students is 7:30-8:00 am in the lower parking lots. Pick up time is 3:25 p.m. in the lower parking lot.

- Parents will drop students off in the foyer as we are limiting those inside the building. The secretaries can see anyone in the foyer very clearly as well as speak with them. The secretaries will sign students in.
- It is recommended that parents call ahead or write a note if picking a student up early. Parents will remain out in the foyer to pick up a student. The secretary will utilize the cameras to see the parent's face as well as speak with the parent before the student will be released. The student will be sent out to the parent. The secretary will sign the student out.

Masks

- Students are required to wear masks on buses. They will keep the mask on until they arrive in first period and sit down at their seat. All students will be provided a pouch to keep masks in during class time so they do not become contaminated.
- Students are required to put masks on before they leave the classroom for any reason. They will be provided hand sanitizer before placing their masks on.
- Students will not be required to wear masks in the classroom. Desks and tables will be strategically placed with dividers as necessary for safety purposes.

Meals

- Cafeterias will be utilized at 50% capacity with only one grade level at a time per commons while utilizing social distancing guidelines as well as social distancing bubbles as a guideline/reminder. The three grades will be placed on a rotation with the third grade level eating in the classroom with the classroom teacher. Those students will be released first to get their trays so they have ample time to get back to the classroom and eat.
- Breakfast and lunch for Wednesday will be provided to students during 9th period on Tuesday.

Nurse's Station

- Designated area for students with a fever.
- Designated area for students who do not feel well.
- Protocol for nurse visit.

Classroom

- Arrows to direct flow of traffic to limit contact and maintain social distancing

- Social distancing bubbles to remind all students and staff to remain the required distance apart
- Desks and tables will be strategically placed with dividers, screen protective plexiglass, as necessary for safety purposes
- All desks/surfaces will be sanitized between students
- Staff will wear face coverings when they cannot provide instruction in a socially distanced manner.
- Students are permitted to wear facemasks if they prefer
- All masks must meet dress code requirements...ex. no profanity, drugs, etc.
- Students can access textbooks from iPad
- Extra tutoring will be available for students during the morning before school, lunch, during 9th period, and after school
- Hand sanitizer is available in every room
- Parents will have instructions as to how to access content and material if we go remote
- Assigned seating
- Students will have everything necessary for education as soon as possible; iPads with loaded apps/textbooks; how to in terms of accessing books, emails, internet, assignments, etc.
- Built in supports for those who are struggling
- Arrows to control the flow of traffic in the classroom as well as in the hallways
- Education on how to eliminate the spread of germs...coughing/sneezing into elbow, washing hands for 20 seconds, socially distancing
- All doors remain open in the hallways as much as possible so nobody needs to touch them
- Use outside areas as much as possible
