- A, B, or a "Not Yet". If a student does not reach a level of master equivalent to and A or B they will receive a score of "Not Yet". This meaning that they have the opportunity to come and correct the assignments that they receive a "Not Yet" score on. That way they can make sure they understand the concepts that we have covered.
- Tests and other major assessments will be graded according to the school wide grading scale.
