Message from the Superintendent

Dear Jennings School District Staff, Parents, and Stakeholders:

Many people said 2020 is the year of vision; but, none of us saw this current reality coming. The Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) is a common enemy to humanity. ennings School District (ISD) and we, the Jennings Warriors, have an essential role and responsibility during this time for the sake of public education and public

While the world has changed, many of our protocols and practices have changed. Still, our education mission and vision are clear and remain. That vision is 'Students First: Transforming Schools and Communities through Enlightenment, Empowerment, and Engagement." Thank you to our entire JSD Leadership Team, Custodians, all essential staff for planning and working hard to assure the highest amount of safety, schooling, and support for everyone in the 2020-21 school year. All ISD employees and stakeholders are essential.

As you likely know, JSD was the first in the St. Louis region to (1) have a COVID-19 Plan approved by officials, (2) make accommodations for childcare for first responders per the request from DESE, and (3) resume in-person classes since school closures in Missouri during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Our July 2020 In-Person Summer Schooling allowed us to pilot many of the COVID-19 Essential Actions for 2020-21 school year safety and wellbeing.

SD COVID-19 Essential Actions Plan (go to www.jenningsk12.org) focuses on 5 top safety actions:

- Physical distancing of at least 6 feet OR 30 square feet:
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) like face coverings; b.
 - Limited Close Contact -- less than 15 minutes when possible, the use of large spaces, and outdoors;
- Frequent real-time data and communication; and
- Agile actions like daily JSD COVID-19 Screening (go to www.jenningsk12.org), over 40 JSD staff contact tracers for tracing, mitigation plans, and reduced building occupancy with an A|B School Calendar

All school year, we must avoid the 3 Cs as much as possible—closed spaces with poor ventilation, physical contact and conversation without at least 6 feet distance and PPE, and crowded places with many (over 50) people.

We have even more difficult days ahead. At any time, lennings School District could need to be 100% virtual learning of all students based on multiple factors. Let us make the most of the days we have together in-person to: Make the safety protocols strong and secure for low to no transmission of COVID-19 in our schools, just like during the July summer school. Ensure that teachers, students, and families understand how to problem-solve, use the necessary technology well, and have good mental health, hygiene, and social-emotional learning practices.

In closing, ISD is amazing. No points of pride from the past are greater than the acknowledgment of who we are and what we do for our region and beyond. The most significant points to be proud of are the present and the future actions and sacrifices for others. That selfless, courageous, commitment to act in times of great need makes American strong. You, public service professionals, are heroes.

The Board of Education and I are proud of you, who you are, and all you do on behalf of the least among us. Living up to the JSD mission, we are truly lifelong learners demonstrating that education is a lifelong pursuit. We are innovative and create stimulating educational environments. We are warriors in this war against ignorance and COVID-19.






