Modern Trade and Tech Hub



Xi'an has over 60 University totaling about 1.2 Million-University Students. Silk Road Start targets a cluster of Universities in Xi'an southern Suburb called Chang An, that the locals also refer to as "University City." Over 20 new College and University Campuses are located in the University representing a population of over 250,000 students. Thousands of these Chinese students hope to study abroad for Graduate degrees. Few foreign students currently study in the "University City" region of the city.
