# WOLCOTT PUBLIC SCHOOLS WOLCOTT, CONNECTICUT SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT JUNE 08, 2020

#### Dr. Gasper's Report:

- I'm thankful to our Fire Chief and Emergency Management Director, Kyle Dunn, for coordinating a very large shipment of PPE to the school system. This shipment was at no cost through the State of Connecticut. We've received masks, gloves, gowns, and face shields. All of these will be needed as we reopen our schools, in some fashion, in the Fall.
- We are in progress of ensuring that each classroom in the district has a hand sanitizer dispenser. Our custodial and maintenance staff are installing these stations now. The sanitizer liquid itself has been ordered and we're hopeful that the backlog for this product will be gone by August.
- Unfortunately, Dime Oil is not willing to work with us on donating surplus heating oil to residents. The Mayor and I are still discussing this issue but it's unfortunate that the company did not feel that they could participate in this project.
- Tonight the Board will discuss a memorandum of agreement with the teachers' bargaining unit. When the Board chose to shorten the school year for students, this created four paid, contracted days for teachers that would not be with students. Two of these days were used on March 19th and 20th when students were home and teachers came into schools to prepare for distance learning. The MOA addressed the remaining two paid days. Because we are anticipating a higher-than-usual number of "incomplete" grades for students, these two days will be used flexibly to complete correcting and grading of make-up assignments over the summer. This is not a form of summer school and the teachers will not be expected to teach new content. This is time for them to correct work that is turned in after the end of the student school year.
- We continue to meet frequently and finalize plans for summer school. The vast majority of summer school offerings will be virtual and designed to help students who have extended school year (ESY) on their special education plans. A very small number of pre-k special education students and a small number of WHS students who need support in credit recovery will come on campus at AES for summer school services. Most other school districts have chosen not to do any in-person learning in the summer. We've chosen to do so for two reasons: we feel that the selected students are the ones that are in greatest need of in-person learning and whose parents have expressed interest in this, and; this will function as a small dry run for implementing the rigorous guidelines released by the state many of which, I feel, are likely to continue into the coming school year.
- We are working hard to get our diploma covers and diplomas from the printer in time for the 6/18 graduation. The printer is a national company located out of state. Our order was placed in February and we are pressing them to get the items here in time but they were closed for several weeks because of COVID. In normal years, their turnaround time is 2-3 months on our order.
- I've received and accepted a request to serve as a mentor to an aspirant superintendent. You may see Lenore Gagain at future BOE meetings and committees as she and I work together to help her obtain her 093 certification.

### **Memorandum of Agreement**

The Wolcott Board of Education (hereinafter the "Board") and the Wolcott Education Association (hereinafter the "Union") agree to the following:

- 1. The Board and the Union are parties to a collective bargaining agreement due to expire on July 31, 2022.
- 2. Article VI of the collective bargaining agreement states the work year for teachers.
- 3. At the completion of the 2019-2020 student school year, there will be two (2) additional teacher work days to be completed.
- 4. The Superintendent has set August 14, 2020 as the date upon which incomplete grades must be resolved.
- 5. Therefore, Board and the Union agree to modify Article VI of the collective bargaining agreement and that the two (2) additional work days will be used for teachers to grade work submitted after the student school year ends, but before August 15, 2020 with the following parameters:
  - a. Teachers will send students a list of all uncompleted work prior to the end of the student school year.
  - b. Teachers are not expected to push out new curriculum or teach during this time period.
  - c. Teachers with standing incompletes are expected to check their email/Google classroom periodically, but not less than once every ten (10) calendar days.
  - d. Teachers will have broad flexibility in the turnaround time to grade such work before the August 15<sup>th</sup> deadline.
  - e. If teachers are on a planned vacation during the first weeks of August, they will let their principal know of such plans and any submitted student work will be corrected when they return.
  - f. If a teacher's student caseload submits work that is in excess of two (2) work days, that teacher will be compensated for the additional time at the rate of \$35 an hour.
- 6. This agreement will take effect if a majority of Wolcott Education Association voting members vote in the affirmative to this change in working conditions for the 2019-20 school year.
- 7. This Memorandum of Agreement and the terms contained herein shall neither establish a past practice nor a precedent with respect to the issues addressed herein.

#### **New Construction**

# Naming/Renaming of School Buildings, Components of Buildings, and/or School Grounds

It is the responsibility of the Board of Education to name school buildings, components of buildings and school grounds. The decision will be based upon its assessment of the special significance of a name or, in the case of an individual, exceptional service to the children of Wolcott. Such recognition requires substantial support and comprehensive review.

In the naming of a previously unnamed building, the Board shall establish a sub-committee as described below to receive community input and to make a recommendation. The names of buildings that are not regularly used by students shall be generic (i.e.: Maintenance Building) and shall be the sole responsibility of the Board of Education.

Individuals to be considered shall have served in the continuous employ of the Wolcott Board of Education for an extended period, usually in excess of ten years, with the name being submitted after separation from compensated service for a minimum period of one (1) year; or be a non-employee of the Wolcott Board of Education who has made an exceptional contribution to the children of Wolcott for an extended period. Particular attention shall be given to local candidates.

The Board of Education will determine when a component of a building is of sufficient nature to be assigned a name. A proposal to name a component of a building shall meet additional criteria: the component shall be representative of a curricular discipline and the individual shall be recognized as appropriate to that component.

The process shall be initiated by action of the Board of Education or by presentation to the Board of a petition representing the signatures of one hundred (100) registered voters of the Town of Wolcott. Once initiated, the Chairperson of the Board of Education shall select a sub-committee for the purpose of reviewing the proposal. The sub-committee shall consist of the following minimum representation:

The Chair of the Board of Education (ex officio)

The Superintendent of Schools (ex officio)

- (1) member of the Budget/Facilities Committee
- (1) administrator
- (1) teacher
- (1) parent of a student enrolled in the Wolcott Public Schools
- (2) residents of the community not represented above

The Board of Education shall make public notice of the formation of the subcommittee and its charge for the purpose of encouraging representative communication. The initiator of the request shall bring before the subcommittee the following documentation/exhibits.

#### For an individual:

- evidence of outstanding achievement
- resume of public service
- ten (10) letters of recommendation

For a name other than that of an individual:

\* a written presentation of the special significance of the name

The sub-committee shall validate the documentation and meet with any and all individuals or groups it deems appropriate. It shall present its recommendation to the Board of Education in accordance with Board of Education bylaws and policies.

Once an individual has been recognized in this manner, it will be the policy of the Board not to rename the facility. Should substantial evidence be provided that would indicate that such recognition is no longer appropriate, a subcommittee of similar structure as outlined above would be established for review. Action to remove this recognition would require a minimum of seven affirmative votes of the membership of the Board of Education.

Temporary Extension of Educator Certificates and Coaching Permits SUBJECT:

In accordance with Governor Ned Lamont's Executive Order 7C, I am writing to provide guidance regarding the extension of educator certificates and coaching permits for educators whose ability to meet statutory and regulatory requirements may be impacted during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Effective immediately, the Bureau of Educator Standards and Certification will extend the expiration date of all Initial and Provisional Certificates (including Interim) and 5-Year Coaching Permits with expiration dates between 3/15/20 and 12/31/20 for 1-year from the date of original expiration.

This extension does not apply to permits and/or authorizations such as 90-Day Certificates, Long Term Substitute Authorizations, Durational Shortage Area Permits (DSAP), Charter School Educator Permits and Emergency Coaching Permits, nor does it apply to Resident Educator Certificates. Educators currently serving under any of the aforementioned permits/authorizations will be able to seek renewal at the time of expiration in accordance with existing policy and procedures.

Educators may continue to renew Professional Educator Certificates online or by mail at no cost to the applicant, in accordance with existing policy and procedures. Additionally, 5-Year Coaching Permit holders are reminded it is their professional responsibility to maintain current First Aid and CPR certifications.

Over the coming weeks, the Bureau of Educator Standards and Certification will automatically update new expiration dates within the Connecticut Educator Certification System (CECS) and will print and mail new certificates to those educators impacted by the change.

SUBJECT: Temporary Extension of Educator Certificates and Coaching Permits

In accordance with Governor Ned Lamont's Executive Order 7C, I am writing to provide guidance regarding the extension of educator certificates and coaching permits for educators whose ability to meet statutory and regulatory requirements may be impacted during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Effective immediately, the Bureau of Educator Standards and Certification will extend the expiration date of all Initial and Provisional Certificates (including Interim) and 5-Year Coaching Permits with expiration dates between 3/15/20 and 12/31/20 for 1-year from the date of original expiration.

This extension does not apply to permits and/or authorizations such as 90-Day Certificates, Long Term Substitute Authorizations, Durational Shortage Area Permits (DSAP), Charter School Educator Permits and Emergency Coaching Permits, nor does it apply to Resident Educator Certificates. Educators currently serving under any of the aforementioned permits/authorizations will be able to seek renewal at the time of expiration in accordance with existing policy and procedures.

Educators may continue to renew Professional Educator Certificates online or by mail at no cost to the applicant, in accordance with existing policy and procedures. Additionally, 5-Year Coaching Permit holders are reminded it is their professional responsibility to maintain current First Aid and CPR certifications.

Over the coming weeks, the Bureau of Educator Standards and Certification will automatically update new expiration dates within the Connecticut Educator Certification System (CECS) and will print and mail new certificates to those educators impacted by the change.


