STAY SAFE, WEAR A MASK!

As COVID-19 continues to spread across the country and the world, we all must remain vigilant. The changes we have had to make to routines and daily life are extremely hard, but these changes are even more important now and in the future. We must stop the spread of this new and dangerous virus. The more steps you and your family can take to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the safer you will be.

If I test positive for COVID-19, I should quarantine for a **<u>full 10 days</u>** before returning to work and immediately notify close contacts.

If I am exposed to a person who tested positive for COVID-19 through close contact, **WITHIN 48 HOURS OF THEM TESTING POSITIVE**, I will quarantine for a <u>full 14 days</u> before returning to work.

I can return to work after quarantining 10 days from testing positive WITHOUT OBTAIN-ING A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT.

I can return to work after quarantining 14 days from exposure WITHOUT OBTAINING A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT.

If I have a positive COVID-19 test, **I do not have to quarantine or get tested again for up to 3 months** as long as I do not develop symptoms.

*Close Contact means: in the presence of an individual at less than 6 feet for greater than 15 minutes CUMULATIVE throughout the day
