

Student Travel and Vacations

The New Brighton Area School District recognizes that families may have situations during the school year that lead to travel outside of the immediate area. The PA DOH and CDC have provided information to help us gauge the safety of travel during the Covid-19 pandemic. If you are planning to travel anywhere outside of PA please review the information below. This information is effective with the Secretary of Health order issued on November 17, 2020, amended as of November 25, 2020 and updated on December 17, 2020.

- Pennsylvanians visiting other states are required to have a negative Covid-19 test obtained no earlier 72 hours prior to their return to the Commonwealth OR to quarantine for 10 days upon their return to Pennsylvania.
 - This does not apply to people who commute to and from another state for work, medical treatment, military personnel by order or directive of a state or Federal military authority, those traveling to comply with a court order, or individuals who are returning to the Commonwealth after traveling outside the Commonwealth for less than 24 hours.

The New Brighton Area School District requires that you contact us prior to your travel or immediately upon return so we can discuss your travel and your child's return to in-person instruction.

Upon your return we will require either:

1. A negative Covid-19 test, dated within 72 hours or less prior to your return.

OR

2. You must quarantine for 10 days. We will utilize a "Nurse Excused" absence so the days do not negatively count against your child as long as he/she keeps up with their school work and virtually participates in their classes.

You must continue to monitor your child for symptoms for 14 days. If your child develops ANY symptoms of COVID 19, please keep your child home and contact the school nurse.
