COMMAS ^{Examples}

Commas are used to separate three or more items in a series or list.

- ❖ Do you want low fat, skim milk, or regular milk with your cereal?
- ❖ Last year, my favorite activities were painting class murals, reading about famous people, and writing our own poems.
- ❖ Tell John, Michael, Samuel, and Luis to select a new book from the collection.
- ❖ After lunch, we read independently, listened to the teacher read, worked on our biographies, and studied our spelling words.
