

Call Out for April 30, 2021

This is Richard Dennis, Superintendent of Elmore County Public Schools.

No employees and 12 students reported testing positive for COVID-19 this week. We are encouraging employees and students to take advantage of free COVID-19 vaccinations when possible. Documentation of vaccinations may prevent self-isolation of personnel and students who have been in direct contact with a positive case of COVID-19 if the vaccinated individual is showing no symptoms. Currently, we are working to provide eligible students that are 16 years or older an opportunity to receive vaccines. High school principals will communicate the process to register your student for future vaccination opportunities. The first possible date scheduled is May 7 and there are several more dates expected to be released shortly.

Middle school standards recovery and credit recovery programs that have been underway since February will end Monday, May 3. Please make sure your student uses these last few days to take advantage of this opportunity to improve previous grades.
