Akram found a piece of ice at recess that looked like a heart-shaped piece of glass.



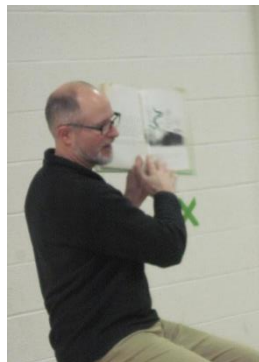
Maverick, the Viking football player, listens as Evan Oltmans reads to his Sidekicks group.
