**Weekly Information Blast: June 17, 2020**

## **Tentative Re-Open Plan**

As it currently stands, schools in Mississippi will be expected to resume this fall. The SCCSD is slated to open August 6, 2020. The tentative plan will be to divide each school's student population in half. One half will report on Mondays and Wednesdays, while the other half reports on Tuesdays and Thursdays. A group of students from the 4 days will report on Fridays based on needs. While students are away from school, they will be working virtually on assignments from their on-site days. Group determinations are currently being made, with consideration of families. Parents will be notified of the specific days. Children in the same houses are being grouped together. ## **Health**

The Mississippi State Department of Health is urging parents to schedule their child's age-appropriate immunizations before summer is over. Mississippi state law requires all children to be immunized before entering public/private school, Headstart, or Daycare. Parents should bring the child's social security card and insurance card (if available) to those clinics. Parents and children over 2 must wear masks in these clinics. ## **COVID-19 Case Confirmed**

An employee at one of our campuses notified us over the weekend of a positive COVID-19 test. The campus was closed immediately (Monday, June 15th) for deep cleaning. All exposed individuals were required to be tested, and are not allowed to return until a negative result is given. No students were exposed to the employee who was confirmed positive.
