First cue card for step 1: Suspend judgment.	Did I list ideas for both sides? If not, do this now.
Second cue card for step 1: Suspend judgment.	Can I think of anything else? Try to write more.
Third cue card for step 1: <u>Suspend judgment.</u>	Another point I haven't yet considered is Think of possible arguments.
Cue card for step 2: Take a side.	Place a "+" at the top of one box to show the side you will take in your essay.
First cue card for step 3: Organize ideas.	Put a star next to ideas you want to use. Choose at least ideas to use.
Second cue card for step 3: Organize ideas.	Did I star ideas on both sides? Choose at least arguments that you can dispute.
Third cue card for step 3: Organize ideas.	Number your ideas in the order you will use.
Cue card for step 4: Plan more as you write.	Remember to use all four essay parts: Develop your topic sentence, Add supporting ideas, Reject possible arguments, and End with a conclusion.
