HOUSTON COUNTY, GA – The Houston County School District will offer parents the opportunity to change their student’s learning option, either to or from distance learning, for the second semester. Open enrollment will be held online Nov. 12-19, 2020, for all K-12 students. Changes will be effective Jan. 5, 2021, the first day of the second semester.

This is the final opportunity to change from distance learning to in-person instruction or vice versa. The learning option will be effective for the full 18-week second semester, from Jan. 5 through May 26, 2021, for all grade levels. Changes will only be accepted during the open enrollment period.

For parents who prefer to continue with their child’s current learning option, no action is required. Students will automatically continue with their current learning

option, if no change is made.

Parents who wish to change to or from Houston Virtual distance learning may visit the district website, www.hcbe.net. From the home page, follow the links on the [2020-2021 Learning Options](#) page during the open enrollment week of Nov. 12-19. Requests will be made online through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. Any parent without computer access may use a computer at their child’s school or visit the Central Registration office to complete the process.
