

Good evening parents of the Randolph County School System,

This is Stephen Gainey. I am calling to make you aware of the following items associated with our school system's plan for opening the 2020-2021 school year:

- 1) In an effort to limit the exposure of schools to possible cross-contamination, visitors and parents will not be permitted to enter the buildings. As a result, parents will not be permitted to walk students down the halls in a school. Staff members will welcome students at the front doors of the school on a daily basis.
- 2) All individuals on a school's campus or other facility in the school system will be expected to wear a cloth face covering at all times.
- 3) Each day, when entering school, the temperature of every student will be checked. If a child's temperature is 100.4 degrees or higher, the child's parent will be called immediately to come to the school's campus to check him/her out of school to go home. In addition, if a student answers "yes" to at least one question on the daily assessment check-in conducted when the child enters the building, the child's parent will be called immediately to come to the school's campus to check him/her out of school to go home. In both cases, the child's healthcare provider or Randolph County Public Health should be contacted immediately by the parent.
- 4) The school system needs the help of all parents in terms of keeping sick children at home. If your child is sick, or has one of the symptoms on the daily assessment check-in form, please keep your child at home and contact his/her healthcare provider or Randolph County Public Health.
- 5) Information about each school's open house event to be held this week can be found on the school system's webpage as well as the webpage for your child's school. Also, the set of questions included in the daily check-in of students is posted on the school system's webpage as well as the webpage for your child's school.

In closing, please note that our school system will provide instruction for every child on each school day during the week. Furthermore, on remote instruction days, students will be expected to engage with their classes at the regularly-scheduled times as used for face-to-face instruction days.
