Fundraisers

Brick Nights

We have bins of building bricks (legos) in storage. Traditionally brick night has included a building contest, raffle prizes, a track where you can build and race your brick car, decorations, etc.

Fall Fundraiser

This is a fundraiser that goes home with the students at our school. Responsibilities include: collecting orders from parents, submitting orders to the company, and finally distributing the orders

Family Restaurant Nights

Throughout the year local restaurants donate a percentage of the sales that day (usually between designated hours) to Stevens school. Restaurants we have done in the past are McDonalds, On the Border, Jake's Wayback, Kiwi Spoon, Scoops and Sprinkles, etc. Your responsibility would be to organize with the restaurant and help promote it

Karate/Zumba/Yoga

These are usually offered after school and students pay a portion of the price. Your responsibility would be to help organize the time/day and promotion of these activities. We also need a parent volunteer to meet the group of students before the activity and to stay until students are picked up by a parent/guardian.

Movie Nights

Traditionally held on Friday nights, the PTO shows movies in the café/multipurpose room. Popcorn is served and parents are asked to stay. Responsibilities include coordinating dates with the school, providing the movie, and getting volunteers to make popcorn.

Halloween Spooktacular

The chair for this event will head a committee of 20-30 volunteers. They will help decorate (the night before the event), set up and run craft/game tables, hall monitors, clean up, photographers, and much more. This committee will meet in early October to plan

Teacher Appreciation Week

This occurs usually during the second week of May. Each day the PTO provides teachers with a special treat. The Board of Education usually provides a meal one day, so it is really 4 days. In the past we have done breakfast, catered lunches, snacks, ice cream truck, cupcake truck, etc.

Teacher Conferences Soup Night

This event is held during the last night of teacher conferences (usually Thursday night). Chair will need to find volunteers to make crock pot soups or desserts for the teachers to enjoy

Yearbook

Yearbook committee is responsible for taking pictures at school events throughout the year, or collecting pictures from parents, and organizing into the yearbook.

3rd grade social/stepping up

This is new this year! In years past we have had a Stevens School/West Hill social to introduce the students before they go to a new school together. Make it your own!
