

Wolcott Education Foundation Scholarship Guidelines

Purpose

To provide financial assistance to Wolcott residents who are current graduating seniors of Wolcott High School pursuing a degree from an accredited institution of higher learning.

Selection Criteria

Applicant must

1. Be in the top half of his/her high school graduating class and be achieving to the best of his/her academic ability.
2. Be active in both school and community.
3. Submit a completed application by the established deadline to include
 - 1.) Acceptance letter from college
 - 2.) Two (2) letters of recommendation
 - 3.) Official transcript of grades
 - 4.) Response to the three (3) questions

If an applicant is a relative of a director of the Wolcott Education Foundation, that director shall not serve on the scholarship selection committee. If an applicant is on the board, that student is eligible to apply but shall not serve on the scholarship selection committee.

Scholarship applications must be presented to the Guidance Department by noon on March 15, 2018 along with all supporting documentation (acceptance letter, two (2) letters of recommendation, official transcript of grades and question responses) to be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
