Summer is quickly passing and thus far we have had few to no students or employees reported testing positive for COVID-19. Based on the current health guidelines, Elmore County Schools will begin the 2021- 2022 school year under normal operating procedures. ADPH and ALSDE guidelines will be adhered to, specifically, quarantine guidelines for direct contact. Employees and students with documented vaccines will not be required to quarantine under current guidelines. As a reminder, any student that wishes to attend virtual school in Elmore County will need to apply to EDGE- Elmore County's virtual K-12 school.
