PS: In today's Bible reading and the themes for today, we'll be talking about our King of Kings. He continues to allow us to administer his affairs here on this earth. We are called to be good stewards of this Church Family as we serve our King Jesus. At this church, we have directors and elders that enable us to teach correctly about Jesus, care for God's people, and direct His ministries here. Today we install our Congregational president elect, the directors and elders you have elected.

Installation of a President Elect, Directors to the Board and Elders:

PJ: Beloved in the Lord, Holy Scripture admonishes us that "all things should be done decently and in order." (1 Cor. 14:40)

To that end, the constitution and by-laws of this congregation establish various offices to which men and women are elected and appointed to serve. In so doing, the Church follows the example of the Early Christian Church as described in Acts, chapter 6:

And the twelve summoned the full number of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up preaching the word of God to serve tables.

Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty. But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." (Acts 6:2-4)

PS: Dr. Ken Saydel has been elected to serve as President-Elect to The Board of Directors of Divine Redeemer.

PJ: Chelsea Chandler and Gary Peppel have been elected to serve as Directors to The Board of Directors of Divine Redeemer

PS: Jim Braun, Jim Healy, and Rick Johns have been elected to serve as Elders to The Committee of Lay Elders of Divine Redeemer.

PJ: Servants of Jesus, you have been chosen to fill specific offices and positions of responsibility at Divine Redeemer Lutheran Church. You are to work with the pastor(s), that our life together in Christ may be orderly and pleasing in His sight.

You are to see that the services of God's house are held at the proper times, that the Word of God is purely preached and taught according to the Lutheran Confessions, that the Sacraments of Christ are administered according to His institution, that provision is made for the Christian instruction of young and old, that the erring are admonished, and the discipline is maintained.

You are to see that the temporal affairs of the congregation and school are properly administered, and that proper support is provided for the workers of Divine Redeemer. You are to assist in caring for the poor and the sick, in cultivating harmony among the members, in promoting the general welfare of the congregation, and in furthering the kingdom of Christ here and throughout the world.

While holiness of life and obedience to Christ are expected of all members of the congregation, it is especially important that you, as office-bearers in His Church, show yourselves, by word and example to be faithful to Him in service and Christian devotion.

In the presence of God and of this congregation, I therefore ask you: Do you accept the offices entrusted to you, and do you promise faithfully to carry out your duties, trusting in the Lord and conforming yourself to His Word in accordance with the faith of the Evangelical Lutheran Church? If so, then answer: I do.

PS: Congregation, you have heard the promises of faithfulness spoken by these men and women whom you have selected to serve as officers of Divine
