Rural Health Services Consortium (RHSC) will be providing sports physicals at your child's school on list date. It has been requested that parents and athletes be informed that for injury prevention purposes, RHSC will complete hernia screenings on male athletes as part of the comprehensive physical examination and in order to provide TSSAA medical clearance. If you do not wish for your son to receive a hernia screening at the school level, you may choose to schedule your sports physical with your primary care physician. If your son has permission to participate in sports physicals at the school level, please sign and return this form. A returned form is required in order to participate in sports physicals at the school level with Rural Health Services Consortium.
