Community

Coleridge School has a rich history of serving the Coleridge community. Established as Coleridge Academy in the early 1900s, the school served students until graduation. Since the early years, Coleridge has gone through several building transitions as well as the grade levels served. Located in the southeast corner of Randolph County, Coleridge is situated in a rural farming community. Throughout the years, parents in the community have supported the school and fostered core values. These values create a foundation which is reflected in students' success.

School

Coleridge Elementary serves approximately 286 students in kindergarten through fifth grade. With 58.68% of our students qualifying for free or reduced lunch, the school meets the guidelines for receiving Title I funding. As a Title I school, our staff meets the highly qualified requirements set forth in Title I guidelines. There are 28 certified staff members serving students of Coleridge. In addition to certified staff, there are 5 classified instructional assistants, and 7

additional staff members serving in classified support positions. Coleridge is accredited by Advanced Education.
