Guidelines for Thanksgiving Lunch
(PreK, 1st, 3rd, 5th, Alexander & Sammons only)

1. Kindergarten, 2nd, & 4th grade students do NOT participate in Thanksgiving lunch. They will not be called to join siblings.
2. No outside food (fast food) is allowed in the building during holiday lunches.
3. Each visitor only needs ONE ticket for a meal (1 ticket is 1 lunch) Miller students do not need a ticket to eat.

News From the Art Room...

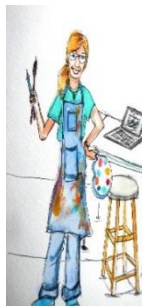
Miller Rockets are hard at work creating ornaments & decorations for a large wreath that will be displayed during the holiday season.
