Impact Aid Program Survey Form Instructions
Survey Date 11/06/2020

The Impact Aid Program is a federal program designed to provide funding to the schools whose students fall under one of the following criteria:

- Reside on Federal property
- Reside with a parent/guardian who was on active duty in the uniformed services as of the survey date
- Reside with a parent/guardian who is an official of, and accredited by, a foreign government and is a foreign military officer
- Reside with a parent/guardian employed on federal property situated in the State of Alabama
- Reside on eligible Indian lands
- Reside in low-rent housing (Section 8 housing does not apply)

If your child appears to be eligible for funding based on the information above, please take the time to carefully read the instructions below, complete the form on the reverse side, and return to your child's school no later than 11/20/2020. Funding is received for each eligible child and is distributed directly back to your child's school.

INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ Only one form per student is to be completed even if student meets more than one criterion.
- ❖ ALL applicable boxes must be filled in with complete information in order to be eligible for funding through the Impact Aid Program.
- ❖ Complete, in its entirety, student's full name, full address (do not use PO Box), and date of birth under *Student Information*.
- ❖ If student resides in low-rent housing, check beside the name of the Federal property under *Student Information*. Section 8 housing does not apply.
- ❖ If student resides with a parent/guardian employed on federal property situated in the State of Alabama, and parent/guardian is not in the uniformed services or foreign military, complete all boxes under *Civilian*.
- ❖ If student resides with a parent/guardian who was on active duty in the uniformed services as of the survey date, complete all boxes under *Uniformed Services*. Branch of Service and Rank must be included to receive funding. If parent/guardian was on active duty for the National Guard or Reserve as of the survey date, a copy of the order reflecting active status must accompany this form when returned to school. This order must be returned to receive funding.
- ❖ If student resides with parent/guardian who was an official of, and accredited by, a foreign government and was a foreign military officer as of the survey date, complete all boxes under *Foreign Military*.
- ❖ Parent/Guardian must certify the information on the form by signature and date of signature. The date must be on or after the survey date (11/06/2020).

All information provided above is required in order to claim eligibility for funding from the Impact Aid Program. For questions regarding this information, please contact your child's school.
