1. Call to Order

Chairperson, Ms. Mary Jan Lollis, called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM.

2. Inspiration

Mrs. Brett shared that she and other parents have been inspired with the great job that Kings Chapel's staff has done with starting the school year so smoothly for the children and the parents. KCES is working well as a team!

7. Presentation(s) to School Council

Mr. Ray, Kings Chapel Elementary School's principal, presented a chart of KCES Strategic Measures of Student Success, SMOSS. This chart highlights six focus areas: Early Literacy and Foundational Skill Development, Literacy, Math Proficiency, Safety, Attendance, and All Students on Track for Success. This chart listed Actions taken and tools used to meet each Focus Area and well-defined forms of Measurement at each Grade Level. The Cougar Leadership Team has worked to develop these actions. Scores from previous years along with a Target score for the upcoming year were posted within the SMOSS. The scores are based on student, parent, and teacher surveys as well as MAP and Milestones scores. Due to COVID-19, Target scores have not been posted for 2021.

8. Report of Principal

Mr. Ray reported on Kings Chapel's budget allotment for 2020-2021 school year. This allotment of funds for our school is based on the number of students in each grade level and the services provided to those students. Mr. Ray explained the thoughtful planning prior to the start of each school year so that all funds are properly dispersed. No funding is added to this allotment. It is set, unlike King Chapel's activity account balance. The school's activity account is fluid with funds raised through fundraisers such as the Cougar Cup Run, Spirit Sales, and Cookie Dough sales. This account helps pay for student programs such as Write Score, Brain Pop, and Education Galaxy.
