

Senior Adjectives, Quotes, and Pictures

It is time to turn in your senior adjectives, quotes, and pictures. Below you will find information concerning all three. Please follow directions closely to make sure all of your information is turned in correctly and on time.

GENERAL INFO

1. All information is due Wednesday, December 18th at 3:00.
2. Adjectives, quotes, and pictures must be turned in on this sheet. They will not be accepted in any other format. *See below for more information about turning in digital pictures.
3. Pictures must be turned in to Skyler Gaskins or Miss Regina. They can also be turned into the office to Ms. Regina's box.

QUOTES & ADJECTIVES

1. All quotes and adjectives must be approved by Miss Regina.
2. Each person's quote and adjective will be unique to them. (This means no two people will have the same one.) They will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. When your papers are turned in Skyler will date them to know whose papers were turned in first.
3. Quotes should not be long. Remember the space to put them in is very small. The longer they are, the smaller the font will be making it hard to read.
4. You will turn in three adjectives. The first adjective you write will be considered your first choice. After that we will go through all three in order. If a conflict arises, a yearbook staff member will be in touch with you to resolve it.
5. You MUST include the person who said your quote originally on your paper. If you do not know who said it, it will be cited to "UNKNOWN." If you made it up, write your name as the author.

PICTURES

1. Pictures must be school appropriate and must be approved by Miss. Regina
2. Pictures can be current pictures or of you when you were younger.
3. It must be a picture of just you. No one else can be in the photo.
4. Hard copies of pictures should have your name written on the back of the photo, and it should be PAPERCLIPPED to this paper. Do NOT staple it. The staple holes will show up when we scan it.
5. Digital pictures must be emailed to jhsybk@gmail.com. The subject of the email should be your name followed by Adjective picture. So Skyler's would say "Skyler Gaskins Adjective Picture."
6. Do not include this picture with your pictures you turn in for your senior page. It must go to Skyler or the email.
7. Screenshot pictures, Snapchat pictures, or pictures that have been heavily edited on your phone may not print well.
8. Original pictures taken on your phone work fine.
