

HISD COVID-19 DASHBOARD

To protect the health of our School Community and per the Emergency Order issued by the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services [Reporting of Confirmed and Probable Cases of COVID-19 at Schools](#) on October 6, 2020, HISD, including the Huron Learning Center and Huron Area Technical Center, will use this document to provide Public Notice to our School Community regarding School Associated Cases of COVID-19 on our website. Within 24 hours of being notified of a School Associated Case by Huron County Health Department, this dashboard will be updated to include new and cumulative COVID-19 case counts. Individuals identified as Close Contacts of School Associated Cases will be notified separately and directly by Huron County Health Department.
