I often have students ask, "why do we have to do presentations and this senior project anyway?" I explain to them, these senior projects give them a chance to look at a career choice they are interested in, and oftentimes it will get them excited about that career or it will help them understand that career might not be for them. The presentation part of the senior project gives students a chance to have their first interview or helps students sharpen their interview and speaking skills. Who knows when they will be the person that has that big interview for a job of a lifetime in front of a very intimidating panel, or when they will be the point person on a collaborative project at their work, or they might be the person that is the speaker for better pay at their workplace. At the least, these presentations give students the first chance to shine, show their expertise, and hopefully give them courage and confidence to nail that first interview in their future.

So parents, grandparents, friends, siblings, or neighbors, when a senior asks if they can practice their senior project presentation to you, please be patient and supportive.
