

FACILITIES PROTECTION

The citizens of each School District have made a substantial financial investment in the school buildings within their district.

To insure the proper care and maintenance of the buildings, the School Boards adopt, as part of the total school facility policy, the following:

1. Painting, coloring and/or marking any area of the school, internally or externally, without specific permission, is prohibited.
 - a. Taping to brick or cement blocks is acceptable, but not to sheetrock.
 - b. Preserve the ceiling tiles; do not affix anything such as tape and tacks.

Anyone wishing to hang minimal light-weight items from the ceiling can request clips to do so. This is to be done in a limited amount per the NH Fire codes.
2. Material is not to be taped, tacked, stapled, nailed, or attached to any area of the school internally or externally including ceiling tiles. Bulletin boards and cork strips should be requested.
 - a. The school board shall provide bulletin boards for the proper display of materials.
3. Any and all requests for exceptions to the above must be submitted, in writing, to the building principal whose recommendation will be forwarded to the S A U #7 Business Manager no less than ten (10) days prior to the next school board meeting.
