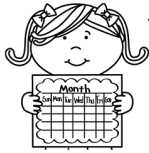

A Note From Mrs. N & Mrs. R



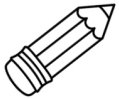

Reading

We are reading the memoir, Lost on a Mountain in Maine. We are focusing on different types of figurative language as we read. The reading comprehension skills we're focusing on include cause and effect and questioning. We continue to review types of nouns, verbs, and adjectives.



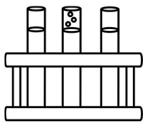
Writing

The students are writing memoirs about an important time in their life. Then they will be writing newspaper articles.



Math

We are finishing our first math unit. We have been working with decimals: Adding, subtracting, and rounding decimals, as well as multiplying and dividing with decimals.



Science

We are finishing our first science Unit. We have spent a lot of time this month looking at mass, volume, and density, and measuring the density of different things.
