A week ago the Governor announced the commitment of Coronavirus Relief Funds to assist districts with the costs of safely reopening schools. Attached please find the distribution of the \$130.8 million that will be going directly to districts to offset additional unbudgeted costs associated with reopening. Funding for academic and support personnel was limited to districts with student populations with greater than or equal to 40% eligibility for Free/Reduced Price lunch. All districts who indicated a funding need on their Re-Opening Survey were eligible for funding for PPE, building cleaning, and transportation related costs.

Please know that if receipt of these funds necessitates a modification of your ESSER grant application we will allow that. Just notify your assigned program manager. For planning purposes please be aware that these funds must be encumbered by December 31, 2020. An application and further instructions on how to access the funds will be coming shortly.

Dear Superintendents,

I am writing to notify you of a revision to the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF) allocation for Transportation in both the personnel and non-personnel related categories. During a review of the CRF Transportation allocations, it was discovered that an older simulation of how the funds were to be distributed was accidently included in the summary of CRF funding that was shared with the districts on Friday. This simulation was derived from an earlier incomplete data set from the reopening survey. In this version, some districts would have received more transportation funding than the estimated transportation need provided in their survey.

Attached is the corrected version of the allocation of CRF funds to support districts' anticipated transportation costs. This change will mean that some districts will see an increase in their allocation and others a decrease. No longer will any district be allocated more transportation funding than their estimated need. Please accept my sincerest apologies for any confusion this has caused.
